1.5 ItemSync: added SerialControlled flag

In input file add column with header EBJ_RTPARAMS.SerialControlled

If value in this column is empty - no changes will be done to the item settings

If value in this column is one of: 'T', 't', 'Y', 'y', '1': SerialControlled flag will be set to true

Any other not empty value in this column: SerialControlled flag set to false

Because of the way we are storing information for SerialControlled and Lot info I had to incorporate this kind of complex logic:

Since item cannot be at the same time Serial Controlled and require Lot Info we have to implement this logic:

We check first if item is SerialControlled

1. SerialControlled is Yes in input file: we'll set LotInfo to No and disregard what is in the input file.

2. If the item is already set to SerialControlled = Y AND we don't change it to SerialControlled = N in ItemSync (value in input file is empty or Yes) we cannot set it to LotInfo, LotInfo will be always No.

So to set item to require LotInfo we have to make sure it is not SerialControlled .

1.6 Add URL as possible option for Item attachments

On Production Sequence screen, next to the Notes icon, you will see a new Attachment icon. This attachment icon will be visible just when corresponding Item has attachment.

Also, added a way to attach URL to Item. When you click on the attachment icon in production sequence, you will get a popup with all attachments for that particular item, even the URLs, then if you press click on them, attachment will be downloaded or you will open a new tab redirected to the attachment URL.

To add the attachment: Admin > Item > highlight item > More Options > Attachment
